Messiah was first performed in 1742 in Dublin than a year later in London. Receiving a modest public reception at first, it has gained in popularity to become one of the best known and most frequently performed choral works in Western music, usually performed at Christmas and Easter.

Michael Cooper, musical director, will be conducting the Singers and the four soloists, Ann Roberts (Soprano), Lamorna Nieuwold (Alto), Robert Peel (Tenor) and Peter Cooper (Bass). Robert Poyser of Beverley Minster will provide Organ accompaniment.
